<b>Confirmation of Entrance Fee (Confirmation Fee)</b> Payable by the parents of each pupil on acceptance of a place.	£1,000
<b>Overseas Confirmation of Entrance Fee (Overseas Confirmation Fee)</b> Payable in addition to the Confirmation Fee by the parents of pupils whose normal residence is outside the United Kingdom.	£3,000

<b>Nursery*</b> The Fees quoted opposite are the full termly fees for the Nursery exclusive of any hours of childcare available under the Government's universal early years free entitlement scheme which makes available up to 15 hours free childcare to 3- and 4-year-olds. The School does not participate in the Government's extended free entitlement scheme for up to 30 hours for eligible 3 and 4 year olds. Childcare vouchers can be used to pay Nursery Fees.	£4,000 per term
<b>Reception**, Year 1 and Year 2</b> **Childcare vouchers can be used to pay School fees up until, and including, the term that the child turns 5.	£4,792 per term
<b>Year 3 to Year 6</b>	£5,427 per term
<b>Year 7 to Upper Sixth</b>	£7,632 per term

Late collection charge – after 18:00, parents will be charged for every 10 minutes they are late, rounded up to the next 10-minute increment.

**Optional instrumental music lessons** – are a private arrangement between the parents and the individual music teachers. The charges relating to instrumental music lessons are invoiced by the music teachers directly to the parents.

Charges per lesson are:

Reception to Year 6 (30 min lesson) £22.50

Year 7 to Upper Sixth (40 min lesson) £28.50

**Learning Support** – In accordance with the Parent Contract, the School reserves the right to charge for the provision of additional learning support teaching where necessary. This will generally be charged at £25 per hour and will be discussed with Parents prior to commencement of such additional support. The charge is reviewed annually.

## Compulsory Extras for Year 7 to Upper Sixth

**Personal accident insurance cover** – £6 per term (compulsory for Year 7 and above and charged in advance)

**Old Lyonian/Alumni subscription** – £49 per term (compulsory for Year 7 and above and charged in advance) and includes life membership of the Lyonian Association, access to career advice, work shadowing opportunities and networking and social events

**School Managed Device (SMD)** – All Senior School pupils must purchase a specified laptop for use in School prior to commencing at the Senior School. This device will be managed by the School. Full details of the device to purchase, including cost will be sent to parents prior to commencing at the School/transitioning to Year 7 and Sixth Form. The cost of the SMD (including insurance) will be approximately £780 for pupils in Years 7, 8, and 9. Pupils entering Years 10, 11 and the Sixth Form will be offered the option of purchasing a more advanced model costing approximately £1,200.
