John Lyon is proudly represented at district, county and national level in a wide range of sports which are split into:

Specialist Sports: Badminton, Swimming, Tennis, Athletics and Cross Country

Across the School, we have a wealth of excellent facilities, including: a 25-metre swimming pool; a well-equipped sports hall; two fitness studios; indoor and outdoor cricket nets and hard-court area on-site; complimented by our all-weather astroturf (floodlit) and 25-acre sports fields at Sudbury.

Sports Scholarship applicants will be active members of the school's top-ranked sports teams and should be currently playing at least one major sport; whilst also demonstrating a growth mindset to be able to make a significant contribution across other sporting disciplines. Applicants would need to play a minimum of one specialist sport at an elite level with the potential of contributing positively towards other sporting disciplines. Applicants will be required to submit a detailed record of sporting achievement, supported by testimonials from their coaches/teachers which demonstrates their potential to develop into an outstanding athlete in their time at John Lyon.

As a Sport Scholar at John Lyon, pupils will be expected to:

- Perform at the highest level in curriculum Physical Education & Games
- Uphold and promote the John Lyon School Values
- Be an ambassador for sport across both the Prep and Senior School
- Fully engage with all aspects of the Sports Scholarship Programme
- Recognise the School will have first priority on their extra-curricular time
- Make a significant impact when representing the School across a range of sports

As a Sport Scholar at John Lyon, pupils will expect to receive:

- An excellent fixture list spanning a wide range of sporting and Co-Curricular activities
- Specialist coaching from teaching staff and sporting professionals
- Access to a range of seminars and workshops to support a pupil's physical, tactical, technical and psycho-social development

- Mentoring from Physical Education and Sports staff to support their sporting journey
- Access to Fitness Suite sessions to complete personalised strength and conditioning programmes
